

# Need Energy Assistance?



The Massachusetts Good Neighbor Energy Fund is available to any Massachusetts household who, because of temporary financial difficulty, cannot meet a month's energy expense and is not eligible for state or federal energy assistance. Last year, the Fund helped thousands of individuals pay an energy bill.

To qualify for assistance from the Fund, an applicant's gross household income must fall between 60 and 80 percent of the state's median income levels. For example, a household size of 4 would need to have a gross yearly income of between \$87,294 and \$116,392 to qualify. The 2023-2024 campaign year's Fund disbursement is \$400 per eligible household per heating season.
